As you may know, since I came to college I've involved in a campus organization called 'Cru.' (or 'Campus Crusade for Christ') Through my involvement with Cru, I have been blessed with many opportunities to grow in my faith. - Majority of college students self-identify as "atheist"

The people of this country need the message of Jesus Christ, and they need a messenger. And so, I am planning on using this **Spring Break to travel to the Netherlands with other students from Cru to reach college students in Holland for Christ**. But the benefit won't be to the Dutch alone. While there, I will learn all about how to reach people in a post-Christian culture. 
After spending the school year working with college students in central Illinois, we were surprised to find out our summer assignment. We will be spending six weeks this summer in Mumbai, India!

This summer God will surely grip our hearts. We will see people in great physical and spiritual need. About 19 million people live in Mumbai. Sixty percent of the people live in slums! 68% are Hindu.



We are going to Mumbai June 14 through July 30 with 18 staff and students to start ministries on college campuses. Currently, there is little to no campus ministry in Mumbai. This is a great opportunity for our students. They will grow in their faith through one-on-one discipleship, prayer, Bible study, and ministry training. The majority of our time will be spent talking with Indian students about Jesus.
